

Terms and Conditions

1. I _____ agree to the T&C below and understand that my course will start at 0845 on the _____ unless otherwise contacted in advance by Triton Scuba.
2. A non refundable deposit of £100 is required to secure a place on any course. If however the cost of the course is less than £100 then the full amount is payable at the time of booking.
3. The remaining balance is payable on commencement of the course. Certification will be withheld until full payment has been received.
4. No refund of monies paid towards any courses will be refunded save those offered by Triton Scuba at their absolute discretion. If a course needs to be postponed and more than 14 days notice have been given then another course date (if available) can be booked free of charge. Failure to attend any part of a scheduled course or notify Triton Scuba within 14 days prior to the course start will incur a fee of £75/day. Triton Scuba reserves the right to re-schedule any portion of courses at their convenience.
5. Entrance fees to inland lakes and boat fees are included in all course costs unless otherwise stated.
6. Any accommodation costs related to courses are at the students' expense.
7. No refund will be given once the course has started.
8. Course fees may change without notice.
9. If the weather or any other circumstances beyond the control of Triton Scuba cause the course to be delayed, changed or cancelled, no liability can be accepted by the aforesaid party for consequential loss, damage or expense incurred.
10. Triton Scuba reserves the right to vary or cancel, at their discretion, a course or its contents, whenever the circumstances necessitate. The minimum number of students required to run a course is 4. Triton Scuba reserves the right to cancel courses when this number of students is not met.
11. Students may not participate in diving activities without a satisfactorily completed medical statement.
12. Triton Scuba reserves the right to refuse admission onto a course or courses.
13. Candidates using Triton Scuba's equipment for any course are responsible for that equipment and will be charged for any loss or damage caused by student negligence.
14. A Buoyancy Control Device will be worn during all open water activities.
15. In the absence of any negligence by Triton Scuba, or its employees, participation in diving training is undertaken entirely at your own risk. Triton Scuba or its staff cannot accept responsibility for any injury or other loss caused by, or resulting from, your own conduct, which amounts to your own contributory negligence.
16. Candidates agree to abide by the rules of Triton Scuba in all diver training matters.
17. The decision of Triton Scuba/course Instructors shall be final in respect of any and all diving and or training matters.
18. Triton Scuba operates an established Complaints and Appeals procedure. Should you have cause for complaint then you should inform your Instructor, or a member of senior management on the same day. You will be asked to complete documentation and the matter will be dealt with within the Triton Scuba Complaints and Appeals procedure.
19. In the event that extra sessions are required to achieve satisfactory skill levels and meet performance requirements, students may (at the discretion of Triton Scuba) receive one free confined water session. Any extra confined water sessions will incur a charge of £30 and any Open water session(s) £75.
20. Students must complete all prescribed reading and coursework prior to attending the first day of the course. Triton Scuba reserves the right to defer a student to another course if all prior reading has not been completed. This will result in the course being rescheduled and a fee of £75 being levied.
